A few practical points that may be of help to couples who intend to marry during 2013: The parish requires a minimum of 3 months notice; Civil notification also needs to be obtained 3 months prior to marriage from Registrar of Births, Marriages & Deaths, Sandfield Centre, Ennis. 6868050: The only pre-marriage courses approved by the diocese of Killaloe are the ACCORD courses, the Redemptorist pre-marriage week-end at Esker, Co.
