The theme of this year's Trocaire Lenten campaign is "Let Justice flow like a riv-

er" (Amos 5:24) and the focus is on 'Water'.

In many African countries 51% of people do not have access to clean water. The Trocaire box and poster features Enestina, a nine year old girl from Malawi. Until Trocaire worked with her community to develop a borehole, Enestina had to carry 15 litres of water twice a day a distance of 1Km for her family. During the dry season the queues to get water can take hours. As a result she frequently missed school or arrived there feeling tired. Trocaire boxes will be available in our Church next weekend.

You are welcome to take one for your home and/or place of work and use it during lent. The people of Kildysart -Coolmeen-Cranny have been extremely generous in the past in support of the work of Trocaire.
